LEGAL REMEDIES

- · Contracts only
 - o Expectation damages: general calculation and calculation in different types of contracts
 - o Consequential damages
 - o Reliance damages
 - o Incidental damages
 - o Nominal damages
 - o Liquidated damages
 - o Punitive damages
- Torts only
 - o Compensatory damages: general damages, special damages, nuisance actions
 - o Nominal damages

- Both contracts and torts: limitations on damages
 - o Causation: actual (both) and proximate cause (torts only)
 - o Foreseeability
 - Certainty
 - o Avoidable consequences (mitigation)

RESTITUTION-BASED REMEDIES

Note: money damages are a bit different between the two but all else is the same

- Contracts only
 - o Money damages unjust enrichment: non-breaching party, breaching party, implied in law contract
- Torts only
 - $\circ \ \ \text{Legal restitution-based remedies: money damages}$
- Both contracts and torts
 - o Legal restitution-based remedies
 - Replevin
 - Ejectment
 - o Equitable restitution-based remedies
 - Constructive trust (property returned, subject to value fluctuations)
 - Equitable lien (prop sold/cash returned, not subject to value fluctuations)

EQUITABLE REMEDIES

Note: contracts have a few unique equitable remedies, all else are the same as torts e.g. injunctions and equitable defenses

- Contracts only
 - o Specific performance, personal service contracts and equitable defenses
 - o Rescission
 - $\circ \ \ Reformation$
- BOTH Contracts and torts
 - o Injunctive relief: TRO, preliminary injunction, permanent injunction
 - o Equitable defenses
 - Laches
 - Unclean hands
 - Misrepresentation
 - Equitable conversation (BFP)
 - Election of remedies
